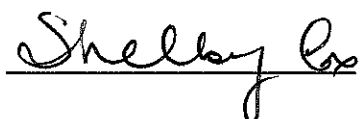

New Business

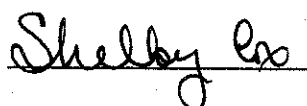
Councillor Pretty inquires about having a water stop for campers to tie into next camping season. Also, suggests a 'scope of work' is needed for repairs on the fire hall.

Mayor Kearney informs everyone that Lawn Day Weekend open ceremonies to begin at 10:45am on August 9th, 2025.

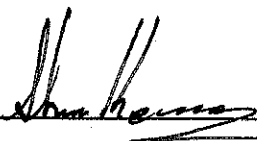
