Mayor Kearney also lets council know he will be resigning from the Waste Management board.


Public Works Department

Discussion took place regarding the pump house on Bayview lane. Letter to be sent to residents letting them know that the pumps can't be turned up any further.


Clean up around town have begun and around the community buildings. The roofing will be put on the museum in the next couple weeks.
