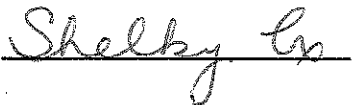

Town Manager informed council that a letter was sent from the department of Transportation stating that the bridge in by the green brook is safe and will be replaced in the next couple of years.

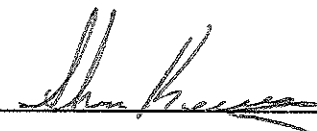
There will be a time capsule project put in place. There will be a poll put out to the public asking how many years should we wait to open it?
